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## CEMENT IN APRIL 2020

This report provides monthly data on the shipments of cement to final customers and the production of clinker in the United States from January 2019 through April 2020. Data on the imports of cement and clinker for April 2020 also are provided.

Total shipments of portland and blended cement, including imports, in the United States and Puerto Rico in April 2020 were 8.1 million metric tons (Mt), a decrease of 7.5% from shipments in April 2019 (tables 2A and 2B). Shipments for the year through April totaled 29.1 Mt, an increase of 3.3% from those for the same period in 2019. The leading producing States for portland and blended cement in April 2020 were, in descending order, Texas, Missouri, California, Florida, and Alabama (table 1A). The leading cement-consuming States (Texas, California, Florida, Georgia, and Ohio) received 42% of April shipments (tables 2A and 2B).

Masonry cement shipments totaled 195,000 metric tons (t) in April 2020, a decrease of 11% from those in April 2019 (table 2C). Shipments for the year through April totaled 750,000 t, a decrease of 2.7% from those for the same period in 2019. The leading masonry-cement-consuming States in April 2020 were, in descending order, Florida, Texas, North Carolina, California, and Tennessee; these States received 58% of April shipments (table 2C).

Clinker production, excluding Puerto Rico, totaled 6.4 Mt in April 2020, an increase of 4.9% from production in April 2019 (table 4). Production for the year through April totaled 23.1 Mt, an increase of 6.0% from the same period in 2019. The leading clinker-producing States in April 2020 were, in descending order, Texas, California, Missouri, Florida, and Alabama (table 4).

Tables 5, 6, and 7 list import data from the U.S. Census Bureau; however, data for clinker imports into the Seattle, WA, and the Detroit, MI, customs districts do not include material trucked in from Canada on an informal-entry basis. Likewise, reported imports of cement into the El Paso, TX, district may be missing significant informal entries from Mexico. Monthly imports can show significant year-over-year changes for a variety of reasons and commonly do not correlate well with consumption levels in the respective import districts in the same month. April 2020 imports of cement and clinker totaled 1.5 Mt, essentially unchanged from imports in April 2019. Imports for the year through April totaled 5.0 Mt, an increase of 11% from those for the same period in 2019.

Measures instituted to mitigate the spread of the COVID-19 pandemic are likely to continue to cause disruptions in the cement industry across the United States and around the world. In New York, one cement plant was idled at the end of April 2020 owing to the outbreak (Global Cement News, 2020).
